

## **THE CODE OF AN INSTITUTE PRACTITIONER**

To be adopted by all Institute Practitioners when using Hypnosis or Analysis.

Do not evaluate for the client other than to indicate a Dominant Personality (D.P.).

Do not invalidate or correct the client's reality (there is no absolute reality, only viewpoints).

Keep all appointments once made.

Do not process a client after 10.00 p.m.

Do not process a client who is improperly fed.

Do not permit a frequent change of Practitioners.

Do not sympathize with the client.

Do not permit the client to end the session independently.

Never walk off and leave the client during a session.

Do not lose your temper with the client. (You could be playing the client's game). ‘

Allow the client to be himself, whatever that may be.

Do not try and process aggressive psychopaths or those guilty of serious criminal behaviour.

Try to help all those who say they need help, but remember some clients do not really want the help they claim and some are beyond any help anyone may give in this universe.

Each client can teach you a little more about the truth of life.

Be willing to be taught and never set yourself above your client.

This Code will increase your success rate. A great many clients are going to be very grateful that you were there to give them processing and that you follow this Code.
