

## **THE CODE OF AN INSTITUTE MEMBER**

The Code of an Institute Member is an adaptation of other codes. The Disciplinary Council (United Kingdom) and Board (U.S.A.) has accepted it as an enforceable code. It is to safeguard Institute Members in general.

- (1) To hear or speak no words of disparagement to the press, public or clients concerning any of my fellow Institute Members, our professional organization or those whose names are closely connected to the Institute.
- (2) To use the best I know of - the Institutes techniques and processes to the test of my ability, to help my clients, groups and this planet.
- (3) To refuse to accept for processing and to refuse to accept money from any client or group I feel I cannot honestly help.
- (4) To notify the Disciplinary Body if I know of anyone misusing the Institutes techniques or processes for harmful ends.
- (5) To prevent the Institute being used to advertise other products.
- (6) To use the Institutes's techniques and processes for the greatest good of the greatest number of horizons.
- (7) To render good processing, sound training and good discipline to those students or people entrusted to your care.
- (8) To refuse to impart the personal secrets of my clients.
- (9) To engage in no unseemly disputes with the uninformed on the subject of the profession.
- 10) To follow the instructions of my Case Supervisor during the period of the Internship.
